My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1) Review the description of the resurrected body in 1 Corinthians 15:42-44. What specific change excites you the most? Why?
- 2) Read Romans 8:22-26. How does this passage relate to the relief of our bodies? Do you ever groan in the sinful world while awaiting the sinless world?
- 3) Read Philippians 1:21-26 and 2 Corinthians 5:1-10. What impact do you think the promise of a resurrected body had on Paul? Why do you think he longs for it so? Do you ever long for it?
- 4) Paul concludes that the promise and nature of the resurrection should motivate the Corinthians to evangelism. Why should it? Does it motivate you?
