REALife Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

1. How does it hit you to see such a detailed account of history written hundreds of years before the events? Some argue that Daniel was written after the fact. (See the link on our website for more details of this) what does that do for your confidence about the future?
2. Try to come up with a comprehensive description of the Antichrist from Daniel 11:36-45. (Also see Daniel 7:8, 11, 20, 25; 2Thess. 2:4; Rev. 13:5-6) What does this future person teach us about the nature of human sin?
3. Why is the resurrection of the body such an important doctrine in the Christian faith? (See Daniel 12:2; John 5:28-29; 1Cor. 15:35-58) What are you looking forward to in the resurrection?
4. Daniel's life ends with a promise of a future inheritance in the Kingdom. As you think about the life of Daniel, what is God teaching you about your life?
