REALife Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

- 1. The second command tells us that we are not to make any idols to worship. (see Deut. 5:8-10 & Exodus 20:46) Are there any idols in your life that tend to push your love for God to the background?
- 2. Are there things going on around you that get you caught up "in the moment" and miss the big picture of what God is doing in your life?
- 3. Paul decided to share the Gospel with Agrippa rather than secure his release. What does this teach us about our priorities vs. our personal comfort?
- 4. Agrippa missed the chance to embrace Jesus because it was not the right time. Are there any things right now that are getting in the way of following God?
