REALife Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

- 3. Read the account of Jesus' temptation in Matthew 4:1-11. How did Satan use this Psalm to tempt Jesus? Has Satan used this Psalm to tempt you? Explain.
- 4. Study Luke 9:23-24. What did Jesus mean when He said that we had to lose our lives to save them? Are you willing to trust that promise in your life?
