- Understand that fear and love of God should exist at the same time. Explain how this knowledge of God shapes our lives. See 2 Corinthians 5:11-21; Romans 2:2-4; 11:22; John 3:16.
- 4) How do we see the fear and the love of God displayed on the cross? Have you ever entrusted your whole life to this Amazing God? What is your next step in growing with Him?
