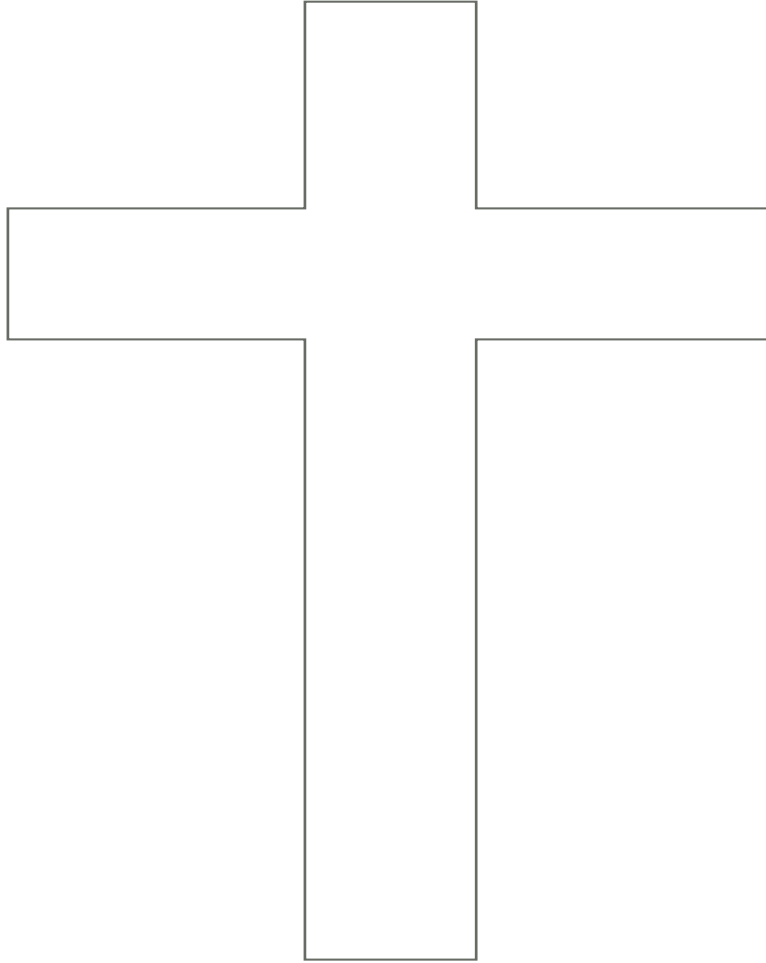

REALife Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or REALife Group.

- 1) As you reflect on the seven words of Jesus from the cross, which one is most impactful to you? Why?
- 2) Study Jesus' words in Mark 15:34 and compare this to Psalm 22:1. Read the rest of the Psalm and compare it to the suffering on the cross. Also see Psalm 22:15 and John 19:28.
- 3) How does the cruciform life get expressed in both the seven words of Jesus on the cross and the Great Commandment in Mark 12:28-31?
- 4) As you prepare your heart for Easter, what aspects of the cruciform life do you need to examine? What actions do you need to take?
