- 1) The direction of your <u>affections</u> will determine your <u>loyalty</u>. *vv*. 15-17
 - A. Love for the world conflicts with love for God.
 - B. The world's affections are not <u>sourced</u> in God.
 - "Cravings of sinful man"
 - "Lust of his eyes"
 - Life's empty pride
 - C. The world is <u>temporary</u>, God's kingdom is <u>eternal</u>.
- 2) Follow the true Christ to remain in the truth. vv. 18-27
 - A. Antichrists lead you away from the <u>family</u> and the truth.
 - B. Christ anoints you with His spirit and truth.
