- 3) Notice how Mary and others experienced joy at the fulfillment of a promise. See Luke 1:46, 2:10, and 19:25-38. How has the coming of Jesus brought joy into your life?
- 4) How are you doing this Christmas? Are you joyful and hopeful about the promise of the King's return? Ask God to fill your heart with joy.
