My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1) Figure the chronology of Abram's life. See his age arriving in Canaan (12:4), at the birth of Ishmael (16:16), and at the birth of Isaac (21:5). Why did God wait so long? What does this say about faith?
- 2) What does God ask of Abram? See 17:1. What is the basic requirement of God for man? See Deuteronomy 18:13; Matthew 5:48; Colossians 1:28. What does it mean to be blameless or perfect?
- 3) What is the value of a symbol? What did circumcision communicate? What symbols does the church have today? Why are they important?
- 4) What area of your life is crying out for growth and change? What resources are available to help you? See 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Ephesians 5:18.
