My Application

During your small group time this week, you'll discuss several aspects of Soul Revolution, such as how your 60/60 experiment is going and key concepts from the weekly messages. You can also use the questions below for your own personal study and application.

- 1) As a gardener prunes the grapevines to make them more productive, so God prunes us to make us more fruitful. What are some things God has pruned from your life? What is He pruning currently?
- 2) Unfruitful branches are cut off and tossed into the fire. (vv.2,6) What does this look like for a believer? See 1 Corinthians 3:10-15, 5:1-5; 2 Corinthians 5:9-10.
- 3) What does it mean to "remain" in Jesus? (vv. 4-5; 9-10) How is Jesus' relationship with the Father helpful to understand the concept of "remain"? (John 4:34; 5:19-20)
- 4) What is the goal of the branch? (vv. 5,8,16) What fruit is God currently producing in your life?
