# My Application

- 1) Contrast the sending of the spies in Numbers 13-14 with the sending of the spies in Joshua 2. What are the differences in these two situations? How did Israel make the most of their second chance?
- 2) Read Ephesians 2:1-10. Reflect on the great grace of God and the second chance He has afforded you. What is the appropriate response to that grace?
- 3) In Romans 6:1-11, Paul outlines the new life we have in Christ. What are some practical applications of “counting ourselves dead to sin and alive in Christ”?
- 4) We have looked at two less than appealing people in the genealogy of Jesus from Matthew 1. How does their appearance in the genealogy of Jesus bring you hope? What does it say about the plan of God for all of humanity?
