# My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1) The concepts of “sentness” and mission are found in both the Old and New Testaments. Can you think of examples of God sending people on mission in the Old Testament?
- 2) Read the following passages: Matthew 9:36, 20:28, Luke 7:34, 19:10 and John 10:10. How does Jesus model the manner in which we are sent? Which one is most difficult for you?
- 3) Think back to the video about Robert sharing the gospel with Jerry at the gym. What are some everyday places that God has sent you? How could you be more intentional about your time at those places?
- 4) Read Philippians 2:5-11. Take a moment and give thanks to God for sending His son to rescue you. What Jesus has done is no small thing. How small do we make it when we fail to share it with others?
