My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. How can persecution and trials make faith grow and love increase? (2 Thessalonians 1:3-4) Could difficulties ever have the opposite effect? Explain.
2. Do faith and love naturally produce hope? Why would hope be missing in people who are growing in faith and love? (1 Thessalonians 1:2-3)
3. Which of the two responses to the subject of “end times” do you relate to: Anxiety or Apathy? Why?
4. What difference does hope make in our daily lives – especially the hope of Jesus’ return? How does that hope differ from anxiety and apathy?
