My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. Re-read 2 Thessalonians 2:14-17. According to verse 14, why were we called by God? If we “stand firm and hold fast” to this knowledge, what will it produce in us?
2. Read Revelation 19:6-20:15. Compare verses 19:8, 19:14, and 20:4-6 with 2 Thessalonians 2:14. Based on these passages, what does it mean to share in Christ’s glory? How does this affect your understanding of the value of “good works” for the Christian? (See also Ephesians 2:10.)
3. According to Revelation 20:15 (and Ephesians 2:8-9), who escapes condemnation at the White Throne Judgment?
4. How does this picture of eternity motivate you to live now? How will it affect the way you relate to friends and family whose names may not be “written in the book of life”?
