# My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. Read 2 Corinthians 10:5. What do you think it means to be “against the knowledge of God?”
2. Give some examples of “arguments” that are “against the knowledge of God.”
3. What would it mean to argue *in favor* of the knowledge of God?
4. How do you know if a voice you are hearing is a worldly one (against the knowledge of God) or a godly one?
5. What do godly voices encourage in you? What do worldly voices encourage?
6. In a practical sense, what does it mean to take your thoughts captive and make them obedient to Christ?
