3. Read about Noah, Abraham and Moses. How would they have been received if they followed God in a similar way today? Does Hebrews 11:13-16 sound a bit like you? Explain.
4. Are you able to make the exchange of your seat or your silence? What is God challenging you to do that requires faith?
