My Application

3. Have you ever given up or given away something for someone you love? What? What is the greatest sacrificial act you have done in your life? What prompted you to give in this way?
4. How do you measure the worth of Jesus in your life? What evidence do you have to show that you love Him as He has loved you? Where would you be today without His death and resurrection?
