# My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 1) As you think about God creating male and female in His image, what does that indicate about God and about both men and women? Is it possible for the genders to be different but equal in quality and value?
- 2) When you see the abuse many women have suffered because of male domination, does it make you hate sin both in yourself and in the world? (See Genesis 3:16-19 and Romans 6:23.)
- 3) Think about the various times Jesus interacted with women. (See Mark 5:25-34, John 4:1-24, John 8:1-11, Luke 13:10-17, Luke 7:36-50, or one of many others.) Which one of these experiences speaks to you most? Why?
- 4) What are some common social pressures that women face today? How can a relationship with Jesus help guide a woman through these pressures? Try to give specific examples.
