- 1) When you look at the whole context of the exhortation in Hebrews 5:11 6:20, who is the writer addressing? Does this give you some insight into the issues they are facing?
- 2) How does God deal with the believer involved in disobedience? See Hebrews 12:5-11. Is this ever extreme? See 1 Corinthians 5:5; 11:30; 1 John 5:16-17; James 5:19-20. Why would God do this?
- 3) Does the writer of Hebrews use the future rewards of the believer as a motivation to endure persecution in the Christian life? See Hebrews 6:12, 10:36, 11:6, 10, 15, 16, 26.
- 4) What are you currently doing to keep your heart from growing cold? How do you keep your life accountable to other believers?
