


## **Five Practices of Islam**

1. Shahadah: Recite the creed

2. Salat: Pray 5 times daily facing Mecca


3. Sawm: Ramadan Fast

4. Sakat: Give 2.5% to the poor

5. Hajj: Pilgrimage to Mecca, once in your lifetime
