Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

- 4. Do you have any conflicts with your neighbors that should be dealt with now? Ask the group to help you make a plan and to pray for you.
