Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. What was written on the scroll in God's hand? See Revelation 5:1; Daniel 8:26, 12:4, 8-9. Why would it require someone other than a man or an angel to open this scroll?
2. What does a lion in the Bible symbolize? See Genesis 49:9-10. What does the lamb symbolize? See Isaiah 53:7 and John 1:29. How do these symbols characterize Jesus?
3. Scripture encourages us to sing a new song for each new act of mercy we receive from God. See Psalms 33:3, 40:3, 96:1, 98:1 and Isaiah 42:10-12. How can you celebrate God's goodness in your life today?
4. The greatest act in history was Jesus dying for our sins. All else falls far short. Have you received the salvation Jesus offers? Does your worship look like the worship of heaven?
