My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. Read the covenant that God made with Abram in Genesis 12:1-3. How is that covenant fulfilled in this passage? Also note the promise of Jesus in Matt. 24:34-35. (“Generation” here means nation.)
2. Will people be saved during the Tribulation? What will life be like for a believer then? See Rev. 6:9-11; 7:14; 13:15-17; Matt. 24:9-14.
3. Explain the symbol of washing their garments white in the blood of the Lamb. Read Acts 20:28; Rom. 3:25; 5:9; Eph. 1:7; Col. 1:20; Heb. 9:22 and 1 Pet. 1:18-19. Why the blood?
4. Meditate on the thought, “God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.” (Rev. 7:17) What are all the implications of this? How does this make you feel?
