My Application

Use the following questions this week to reflect on what it would mean to align yourself with the truths taught in Scripture. Each question is meant for both personal reflection and as a catalyst for discussion with your family, friends, or small group.

1. Look carefully at the beginning of Babylon and note anything that would parallel the Babylon described in Rev. 17. (See Gen. 10:8-10, 11:1-9). How does this contrast with the City of God in Rev. 21:2-5?
2. Note the language used to describe the religious system and its false worship. (See Rev. 17:1-6, 15-16). How should believers view Non-Christian religions? Is there a balance between tolerance and truth?
3. Why is God judging “Babylon the Great” in Rev. 18? (See Rev. 18:4-8, 20, 23-24). Why is materialism so dangerous? How does it lead people astray?
4. In light of what is coming in the end, what is Peter’s advice for us today? (See 2 Peter 3:10-13). Does this type of outlook on life characterize you?
